Dear Parents and Juniors

Our commitment to your privacy

Due to new guidelines, from 25th May 2018, we want to inform our members of how we collect, store and handle personal data.

Why we collect your personal data

We hold your personal details to ensure we have up to date information. We use this to contact you (including parent or guardian contact details). We are required to be aware of any current and relevant medical information. We need parent or guardian permission to allow a junior to travel to and from matches; to be photographed, filmed and recorded. We must have guidance and permission on how we are allowed to use such images and recordings.

How we collect and store your data

This is via paper form from completing renewal membership forms and junior information and contact sheets. We hold phone numbers only to be shared within the club, for example, to arrange matches. Data we collect is either stored locked away if paper form or password protected if electronic. Once paper copies are no longer required they will be shredded.

Sharing your data

We never share you information to a third party outside of the club. Members should also be aware their role in not sharing other members data without their permission.

Know your rights

You may access your data the club hold for you, update it as needed and opt out of receiving communications from us at any time.
